Helpful Hints for Playing the Recorder 1) Hold your body straight and relaxed 2) Left hand is on top 3) In playing the recorder, fingers are numbered, starting with the index finger: 1, 2, 3 The left thumb covers the thumb hole at the back 4) Use the pads of your fingers, not the fingertips 5) Place the mouthpiece between the lips
